Novena in Honour of St Ignatius of Loyola 22nd to 30th July 2018. St Ignatius of Loyola (23 October 1491 - 31 July 1556) founded the religious order called the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). At the Battle of Pamplona in 1521 he was gravely injured during the war. A cannonball hit him and wounded his legs. While recovering from surgery, he underwent a spiritual conversion which led to his experiencing a call to religious life. Father Joachim De Melo, S.J. will lead the Novena and give us a glimpse of the life of Ignatius over the nine days of the novena.

Marriage Paperwork - Over the past few months a number of couples have come to the parish to complete their paperwork. A GENTLE REMINDER - you need to give 6 MONTHS NOTICE of ANY MARRIAGE - whether it is taking place HERE or ABROAD in INDIA, PHILIPPINES or elsewhere. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE.
