West London Citizens Fair Work Listening Campaign in St Anselm's Church May 2018. Father Gerard writes: Over the last 3 years we have successfully campaigned to get the London Living Wage for workers at Heathrow Airport. As contracts come up for renewal at Heathrow Airport the Heathrow authorities will insist on the London Living Wage being paid to workers and an end to zero hour contracts. Following on from the success of the campaign we would like to run a Listening Campaign during May to gather what issues and difficulties parishioners are facing in the workplace, alongside low pay.

We have already had very useful conversations with a number of our parishioners and we would like to invite you to be part of our listening campaign. We will use the results to gather data and stories of people's experience. None of the information you share will be used in any way that could identify you without your consent. We invite you to take part in this exercise. It involves meeting with one of our parish volunteers from West London Citizens, having a private conversation with them and completing a questionnaire. If you would like to take part please either speak to one of our volunteers at the end of Mass this weekend.
