**Lenten Alms – Cardinal's Appeal:** A few weeks ago, you may have heard our Cardinal Archbishop's Pastoral Letter, in which he spoke of the Cardinal's Lenten Appeal in support of key areas of work in our Diocese. The Cardinal's Lenten Appeal was set up in 2015 to fund the innovative work of Catholic parishes, schools and charities working within the Diocese, contributing to three fundamental mission areas of the Church: Marriage and Family Life – enriching and supporting marriages, the essential building block of society and the Church. Youth and Evangelisation – supporting young people, the future of the Church, as they grow in their relationship with God and deepen their Catholic faith. And the Church's Social Outreach within Civil Society – putting our faith into action through projects that serve the poor, the lonely and the marginalised. These mission areas embody how we live out the Gospel and put our Catholic values into action – in service to others through practical programmes. The Cardinal's Appeal has very generously supported outreach work in St Anselm's Parish. This year it made grant of £45,000 to support the work of Hope for Southall Street Homeless and in Summer 2016 it gave a grant to cover the cost of our Parish Summer Youth Camp. Cardinal's Lenten Appeal donation leaflets are attached to the newsletter. Next Sunday there will be a special collection for the Cardinal's Appeal.

**Cold Weather And The Homeless:** In this extremely cold weather, everyone is being asked to do what they can to ensure that no one is without shelter and a warm safe place to sleep. At the present moment there are 20 guests staying in Hope for Southall Street Homeless shelter provided and the three other guests in the Rectory. In addition a severe weather emergency shelter for 37 more people has been opened in St John's Church in Church Avenue.
