The National Eucharistic Congress The largest gathering of Catholics in England since Pope Benedict's visit in 2010 takes place in Liverpool September 8-9. We unite in worship of our Lord truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, with the aim of promoting Eucharistic Adoration, where so many people have experienced the love and presence of Christ. The Echo Arena in Liverpool - which can accommodate 10,000 pilgrims - will be the home to a six-hour stage programme on the 8th September and will include a Congress Mass, keynote speakers Bishop Robert Barron and Cardinal Vincent Nichols, and a drama highlighting the beauty of reverence and devotion. On the Sunday there are Masses in the Metropolitan Cathedral and a large outdoor Blessed Sacrament procession. Many other events and a Youth Congress will supplement the official programme. Thank you to those who kindly accepted the invitation to attend published earlier this year in the Newsletter. A party of ten from our parish including Father Gerard and Deacon Stephen will be attending the Congress.
