A Prayer On Holocaust Sunday God of the past, present, and future, we remember today, 75 years since the liberation of Auschwitz, the six million Jews murdered in the Holocaust, the millions of other victims of Nazi persecution, and all those who have been targeted and killed in subsequent genocides. We remember those who, having survived genocide, share their stories with us: We give thanks to You for the lessons of human stories, both in their suffering & in their joy. We remember those who stood up against injustice and saved lives: We give thanks to You for their example. Together we acknowledge the sacrifice of those that stood together with those who suffered during the Holocaust and other genocides. And we affirm that every life is loved by You and sacred. So we pray that You will inspire us now as we stand together on this day in the love that we know of God in Christ Jesus. Let us commit to remembering: And glorify God in our words and actions. We make these prayers in the name of Christ Jesus who, through His life, death, and resurrection, journeys with us into the eternal hope of Your truth and light. Amen.
