BAPTISM OF THE LORD: Today completes the liturgical season of Christmas. We see Jesus revealed as the Son of God at his Baptism in the Jordan by John the Baptist. The voice of the Father is heard: "This is my Son, the Beloved, may favour rests on him". Thus, as He was revealed to the shepherds at His birth and then to the Wise Men at the Epiphany, we celebrate the news that "God is with us" at His Baptism. In some traditions, "Christmastide" actually lasts for 40 days until the Presentation in the Temple on February 2nd, when Christ is revealed to Simeon as the "Light of all Peoples". In keeping with this, we will keep the crib in place on the sanctuary until the Feast of the Presentation on 2nd February.
