The PASSION, DEATH & RESURRECTION 2023 (PDR 2023). The Parish Youth (SARYM) will be enacting the PDR on 25th and 26th March, after the 6:30 pm Mass. You are invited to journey with Jesus along with from the Manger to the Cross, from the Cross to the Grave and from the Grave to the Resurrection.

Passover Meal and The Last Supper: The Seder meal remembers the Israelites in flight when they were freed from the Egyptians and left in haste for the Promised Land. The meal includes wine, unleavened bread, and bitter herbs, with each, according to the ritual, connecting with the experience of the Israelites. At the Last Supper, on the night before His crucifixion, Jesus offered bread and wine, instructing his followers to do so “in remembrance” – the same command that God gave the Israelites when he asked them to celebrate the Passover as a perpetual memorial. *Parishioners are invite to be part of this celebration, which will take place on Friday 31st March at 7:30 pm in the Parish Hall.
