**Treasurer role with homelessness charity – Volunteer needed:** The charity Hope for Southall Street Homeless (HSSH) is looking for a volunteer to become its Honorary Treasurer. HSSH is looking for someone who has experience of managing an organisation's finances. If that person has taken care of a charity's finances, that would be a bonus. With the assistance of a Bookkeeper, the tasks of the role would take less than 3 hours a week to start with and nearer 2 hours normally.
