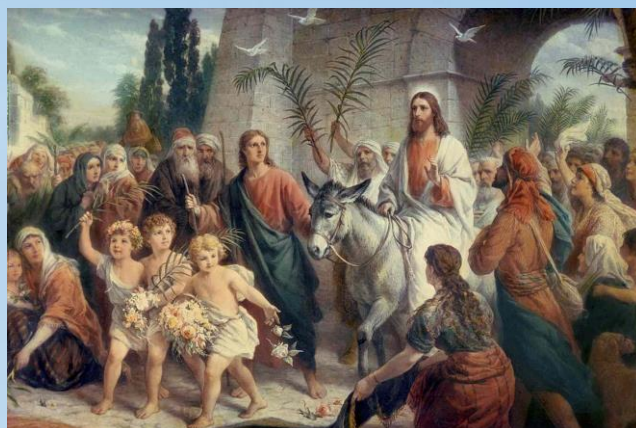

HOLY WEEK TIMELINE EXPLAINED

APPROXIMATE TIME TABLE OF THE EVENTS

During the last week in the life of our Lord

Sunday: (a). Jesus enters Jerusalem. (b). Preaching in the Temple and returns to Bethany for the night.

Monday: (a). Early morning Jesus goes back to the Temple to preach. (b). on the way Jesus curses a fig tree (symbol of Israel). (c). after spending the whole day preaching at the Temple, Jesus withdraws again to Bethany for the night.

Tuesday: (a). on their way to the Temple the apostles discover that the fig tree has dried up to its roots. (b). bitter discussions between Jesus and the leaders who try to trap him. (c). on the way back to Bethany in the evening Jesus announces the destruction of Jerusalem and the end of the world.

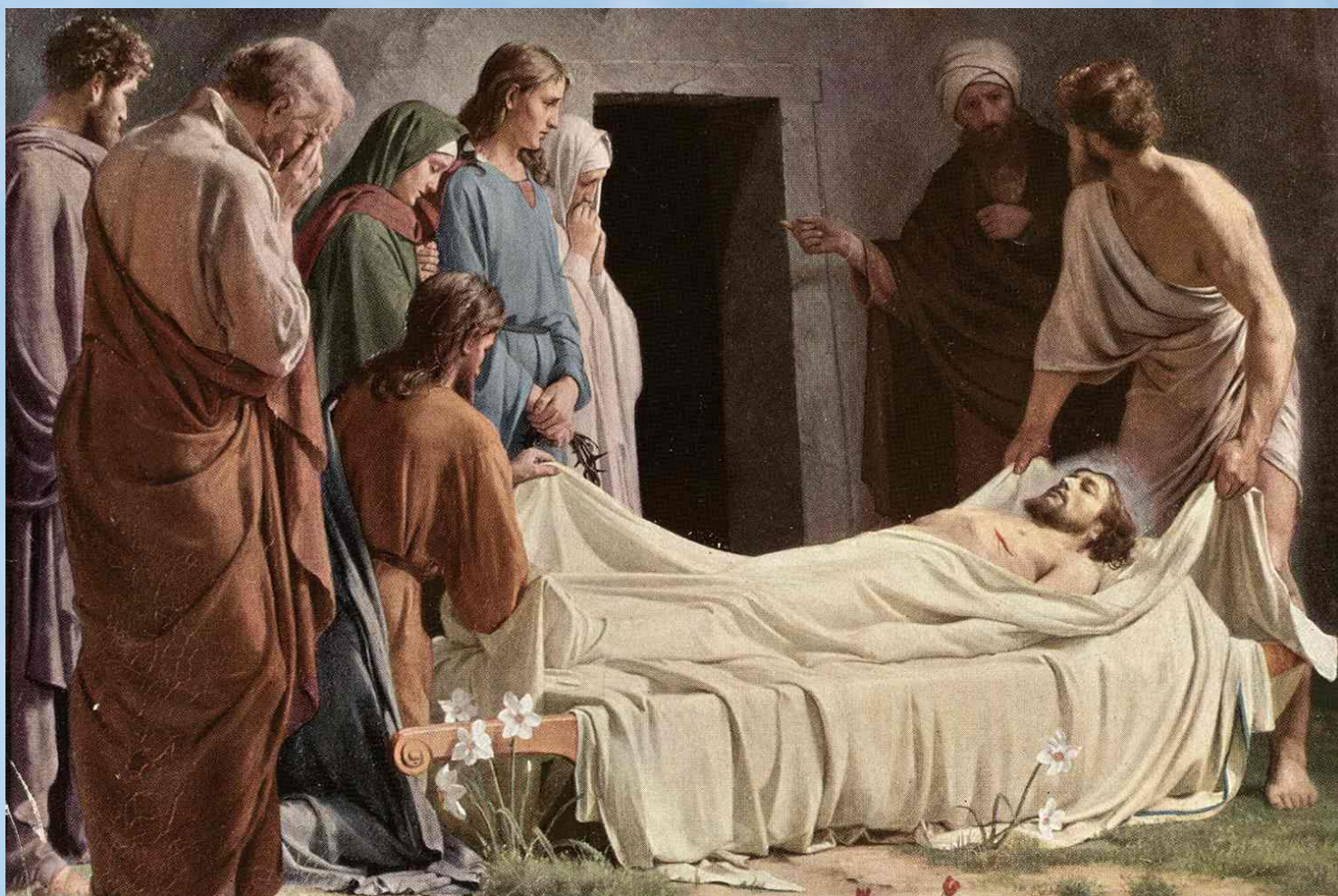
Wednesday: (a). Jesus spends the day at Bethany preparing for his passion announces His death at 6:00 am (Mt.:26:2). (b). High priests plan Jesus' death. Judas enters into a deal with the leaders to betray Jesus at 6:00pm.

Thursday: (a). in the morning Jesus sends Peter and John to prepare the Passover meal. (b). towards the afternoon he goes to Jerusalem for the meal accompanied by the rest of the apostles.

Good Friday: 2:00am- Jesus kept in custody.

9:00am - Jesus is handed over to Pilate; first part of the trial. He is then taken to Herod, and brought back to Pilate; second part of the trial.
11:00am- Jesus is condemned by Pilate (Jn.19:14).
-He is scourged and crowned with thorns.
-Journey to Calvary.

- 12:00pm- Jesus is nailed to the cross (Mk.15:25).
-The three hours agony.
- 3:00pm - Jesus dies on the cross (Mt.27:46).
-Joseph of Arimathaea asks Pilate for the body of Jesus.
-Nicodemus brings ointment for the burial.
- 5:00pm - Provisional burial of Jesus thus, **BEGINNING OF THE PASCH.**



Saturday: (a). the body of Jesus rests in the tomb. (b). the tomb is sealed and a guard posted at the entrance.

Sunday: 5:00am- **-RESURRECTION OF JESUS.**

- The women go to the tomb to complete the burial of Jesus.
- Finding it empty Mary runs to give the news to the apostles
- Peter and John rush to the tomb.
- Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene and to the women.
- Sometime later in the day He appears to Peter.
- 3:00pm- -Jesus joins the two disciples going to Emmaus.
- 5:00pm- -The two disciples recognize Jesus as He blessed and broke the bread.
- They rush back to Jerusalem to convey the news to the rest of the apostles.
- 9:00pm- -Jesus appears to the apostles gathered together (minus Thomas).
