Council of Portuguese Communities (CCP) Elections: Goans in UK with Portuguese nationality face many hardships pertaining to Consulate work. To ease these hardships and have a proper representation of UK Goans in the Portuguese Consulate, two of our Goans Wilson Fernandes and Chris Da Costa will be contesting the Council of Portuguese Communities (CCP) elections on 26th November. CCP is the Portuguese government's advisory body for policies relating to emigration and Portuguese communities abroad. You will all agree Portuguese Goans need a representation at the Consulate and to make this happen, first you need to give your details to Wilson or Chris to validate you are entitled to vote as a Portuguese citizen and the second most important task is to go to vote at the Consulate. This is your opportunity to have Goans represent you at the CCP. You can contact Wilson or Chris after the weekend Masses.

REPAIRS OF THE CHURCH ROOF: To fix this problem we have received a quote from Harrow Roofing Ltd for £10,800.00(including VAT). This will cover the cost to strip roof down to rafters, remove all rubbish from site, New OSB boards to be laid, fixed with angular nails, timber to be fitted to channel the flat roof to an outlet, Arris rail to be fitted internally, new roofing systems to be laid, 3 layers of felt, one layer of tack on felt, followed by two torch on, Technotorch cap sheet and lead outlet to be built with small outlet. See photos of the church roof that needs urgent repairs. We will need the financial support of our parishioners to help carry out these urgent roof repairs. We have received £10,278.39 towards this appeal thank you for your generosity.
