REPAIRS OF THE CHURCH ROOF: To fix this problem we have received a quote from Harrow Roofing Ltd for £10,800.00(including VAT). This will cover the cost to strip roof down to rafters, remove all rubbish from site, New OSB boards to be laid, fixed with angular nails, timber to be fitted to channel the flat roof to an outlet, Arris rail to be fitted internally, new roofing systems to be laid, 3 layers of felt, one layer of tack on felt, followed by two torch on, Technotorch cap sheet and lead outlet to be built with small outlet. See photos of the church roof that needs urgent repairs. We will need the financial support of our parishioners to help carry out these urgent roof repairs. We have received £11,371.40 towards this appeal thank you for your generosity.
