Dear Parishioners, thank you for your generosity and your continual support. With your help, we have been able to pay the entire amount i.e. £52,800.00 (including VAT) for the roof work. St Anselm's Church RAAC investigations: Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) is a building material that was used in constructions from 1950's until mid-1990's. **This material is declared to be unsafe by the UK government.** As St Anselm's Church was built in the 1950's, RAAC testing of St Anselm's church building and the parish centre was carried out by Diocesan approved contractors on the 20th & 21st of May. I am pleased to inform the parishioners that **no RAAC construction was identified within the roof of Southall Parish.** Thank you for your prayerful support.
