Dear Parishioners, thank you for your generosity and your continual support. With your help, we have been able to pay the entire amount i.e. **£52,800.00** (including VAT) for the roof work. We are yet to pay the scaffolding cost as it was not part of the removing, clearing and laying of the new roof. With regard to the Heating, we are still awaiting decision from the diocese. The quote received for the two commercial boilers is **£64,629.50** (including VAT). Meanwhile we as a parish need to raise this amount so that we can make all the payments on completion of the works. Hence, anyone wishing to make a donation to fund these works, please contact the parish office.

St Anselm's Church RAAC investigations: Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) is a building material that was used in constructions from 1950's until mid-1990's. **This material is declared to be unsafe by the UK government.** As St Anselm's Church was built in the 1950's, RAAC testing of St Anselm's church building and the parish centre was carried out by Diocesan approved contractors on the 20th & 21st of May. I am pleased to inform the parishioners that **no RAAC construction was identified within the roof of Southall Parish.** Thank you for your prayerful support.
