Dear Parishioners, thank you for your generosity and your continual support. With your help, we have been able to pay the entire amount i.e. **£52,800.00** (including VAT) for the roof work. We are yet to pay the scaffolding cost as it was not part of the removing, clearing and laying of the new roof. With regard to the Heating, we are still awaiting decision from the diocese. The quote received for the two commercial boilers is **£64,629.50** (including VAT). Meanwhile we as a parish need to raise this amount so that we can make all the payments on completion of the works. Hence, anyone wishing to make a donation to fund these works please contact the parish office.
