Dear Parishioners, thank you for your generosity and your continual support. The quote we received for the two commercial boilers is **£74,999.52** (including VAT). With your help, we have been able to raise **£59,101.50** for the boilers. Furthermore, we have received a grant of **£ 20,000.00**. Update on Boiler replacements at St Anselm's: The first phase of the construction period of the boiler replacement project will begin on Tuesday 29th October 2024. This phase will be the removal and disposal of the existing boilers in the church and presbytery and it will not affect the services in the church. We look forward to completion of the boiler replacements hopefully by the end January 2025, as scheduled by the property office of the Diocese.
